Isle of Wight Observatory, Newchurch. Dark Skies are special areas where there are low levels of light pollution. When there is an absence of light pollution thousands of stars are revealed at night, this is beneficial to the wildlife and tranquillity of an area. We are lucky that much of the Isle of Wight has a high quality of night sky. This is especially apparent within Wight AONB. The Dark Wight Skies event is an introduction to the world of astronomy, the benefits of the Island's Dark Skies and the Dark Wight Skies Initiative (www.darkwightskies.com) which is the ambition to achieve international recognition for the Island's night sky. The event has been organised in partnership with Vectis Astronomical Society. Visitors will be able to use a range of telescopes to see the stars, including the Orion Nebula, which is in the mid southern sky during February evenings.
