

National Apprenticeship Week



National Apprenticeship week 9th – 13th March





- since 2010, there have been over 2 million apprenticeship starts in England
- apprenticeships are available in over 170 industries including aerospace, fashion, broadcast media and finance – with 1500 job roles available
- in 1914 most apprentices started work aged 15 to 17, compared with 19 to 24 today
- women now take up 55% of apprenticeships
- 19% of advanced apprentices progress to Higher Education
- higher apprenticeships are available in 40 subjects
- 100 years ago the most common apprenticeship was dressmaking, followed by engineering
- 90% of apprentices stay in employment after finishing their apprenticeship (includes 2% self-employed)
- 71% of apprentices stay with the same employer
- 82% said their apprenticeship had improved their ability to do the job and 79% said that their career prospects had improved
- 100 years ago an apprentice could be summoned to court for being 'idle' or having a 'bad attitude'
- more than 850,000 people have been earning and learning on an apprenticeship in 2013 to 2014
- up to 25,000 apprenticeship vacancies available online at any one time
- there were 1.4 million online applications in 2012 to 2013
- there has never been a better time to employ an apprentice, or start an apprenticeship





APPRENTICESHIPS

Become an apprentice

1. Overview

Apprenticeships combine practical training in a job with study. As an apprentice you'll:

work alongside experienced staff
gain job-specific skills
earn a wage and get holiday pay
study towards a related qualification (usually one day a week)

Apprenticeships take 1 to 4 years to complete depending on their level.

2. Levels of apprenticeship

An apprenticeship has an equivalent education level and can be:

Intermediate - equivalent to 5 GCSE passes
Advanced - equivalent to 2 A level passes
Higher - can lead to NVQ Level 4 and above, or a foundation degree

3. Who can apply

You can apply for an apprenticeship if you're:

16 or over eligible to work in England not in full-time education

4. How to apply

There are 3 steps to applying for an apprenticeship.

- 1. Search for an apprenticeship.
- 2. Sign in or create an account.
- 3. Complete and submit your application.

The <u>National Careers Service</u> has advice on writing applications and what to do at interviews.





A Carillion apprenticeship is a great way to start a career in the construction industry – with no costs involved. Carillion is recognised as one of the best construction training providers in the country.

How much will I get paid?

As a baker, you would use a range of methods to produce bread and confectionery products. You would usually work in one of three types of bakery. If you are passionate about food and enjoy baking, this could be just the type of job you are looking for.

To become a baker, you will need to have good number skills for measuring ingredients. You will also need these for ordering supplies and working out cooking times.

You can work as a trainee in a bakery without any specific qualifications. Some employers might ask for GCSEs in English, maths or food technology.

At a plant bakery, you would use machinery and production lines to manufacture large amounts of baked goods for shops, supermarkets and other large customers.

As an in-store baker, for example with a supermarket, you would use some automated machinery to make fresh bread products to be sold in the store.

At a craft bakery, you would create a smaller amount of products to be sold in a shop, delicatessen or chain of specialist shops. This work would be more varied, and although some machinery is used, you would do much of the work by hand.

Hours

You would usually work 39 hours a week over five days, with very early starts. Plant bakeries usually operate shifts on a rota system, which include nights and weekends. As an in-store or craft baker you would also be expected to cover weekends.

The work involves a lot of standing as well as lifting and carrying trays and heavy sacks of flour, although lifting equipment is widely used.

RAISING THE PARTICIPATION AGE

Information for young people

The age to which all young people in England are required to continue in education or training has been increased.

This is being introduced in 2 stages:

- if a young person left year 11 in summer 2013, they must stay in some form of education or training for at least a further year until 27 June 2014
- if a young person started in year 11 (or years below) in September 2013, they will have to continue until at least their 18th birthday

This does not mean young people must stay in school. They will able to choose from the following options:

- full-time education (eg school or college)
- an apprenticeship
- full-time employment or volunteering, combined with part-time education or training

CHILD EMPLOYMENT

Children (under 16 years of age) are not allowed to work:

- without an employment permit issued by the education department of the local council, if this is required by local bylaws
- in places like a factory or industrial site
- during school hours
- before 7am or after 7pm
- for more than one hour before school (unless local bylaws allow it)
- · for more than 4 hours without taking a break of at least 1 hour
- in most jobs in pubs and betting shops and those prohibited in local bylaws
- in any work that may be harmful to their health, well-being or education
- without having a 2-week break from any work during the school holidays in each calendar year

There are also special rules which only apply during term times and school holiday times.

Term time rules

During term time children can only work a maximum of 12 hours a week. This includes:

- a maximum of 2 hours on school days and Sundays
- a maximum of 5 hours on Saturdays for 13 to 14-year-olds, or 8 hours for 15 to 16-year-olds

School holiday rules

During school holidays 13 to 14-year-olds are only allowed to work a maximum of 25 hours a week. This includes:

- a maximum of 5 hours on weekdays and Saturdays
- a maximum of 2 hours on Sunday

During school holidays 15 to 16-year-olds can only work a maximum of 35 hours a week. This includes:

- a maximum of 8 hours on weekdays and Saturdays
- a maximum of 2 hours on Sunday




