Council Policy March 2008

- Primary / secondary model.
- 4-11 primary schools.
- 11-19 secondary schools.
- Primary schools are established with a mix of 1 & 2 classes per year group.
- Secondary schools are established with 11-14 (lower) and 14-19 (upper) sections.

Council Policy March 2008

- Primary schools are achieved by enlargement and/or amalgamation wherever possible.
- New secondary schools (5) are let by competition.

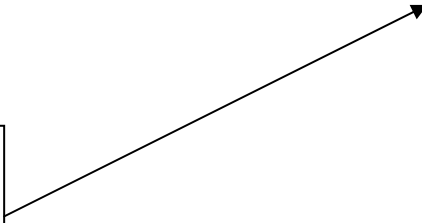

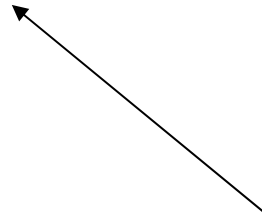


Revised proposal

New Schools:

Secondary

- Five 11-19 secondary schools opened on the existing high school sites. All to be let by competition.

Primary

New primary schools in:

- East Cowes on the Osborne Middle site.
- West Wight on the West Wight Middle site.
- Rural school on a site at Godshill.

Possible waivers to competition for all these schools

South East & East Area

Schools Closing with no future provision:

- All Middle Schools.
- Chale CE Primary.
- St. Helens Primary.
- Weston Primary.

**All other provision tom be achieved by enlargement or
amalgamation**

Possible Transition

- 1 September 2010 the governance and leadership of schools changes.
- If a pupil is in Year 4 in July 2010 they will remain in their current primary school as a Year 5 pupil in September 2010.
- If the primary school is closing the pupils may transfer to the new school site or remain on the current site for a period of time subject to the stage of the new building development.

Possible Transition

- If a pupil is in Years 5, 6 or 7 in July 2010 they will remain on their current middle school site as a Year 6, 7 or 8 pupil in September 2010. The site will come under the leadership and governance of the new area secondary school.
- If a pupil is in Year 8 in July 2010 they will transfer to the new area secondary school as a Year 9 pupil in September 2010.
- **No Year 6 pupils will move back to primary**

What Next

- The final date for consultation is **Friday 26 September 2008.**

Subject to the outcome of consultation:

- A report will go to Cabinet to approve Statutory Notices & Invitations to Bid (competition invites) in **October 2008.**
- Invitations to Bid will be published in **November 2008.**
- Statutory Notices will be published in **March 2009**
