<b>Decision reference</b>	33/08
<b>Decision taken</b>	Option (a) - Lead commissioning.
<b>Reasons for decision</b>	To approve a model for the joint commissioning of adult health and social care services for individuals with a learning disability or a mental health illness.
<b>Additional reasons</b>	<p>To have an agreed definition of joint commissioning between the Council and the PCT and the role of each organisation in the commissioning of adult mental health and learning disability services.</p> <p>One organisation has to lead the commissioning of a service and take accountability for its organisation and delivery.</p> <p>Using this model, the PCT will continue to lead on the commissioning of adult mental health services and the Council will take the lead for learning disability services.</p>
<b>Options considered and rejected</b>	<p>Option (b) – Joint commissioning.</p> <p>Option (c) – Single organisation commissioning.</p>
