Decision taken	Option 1 - THAT the draft coastal defence policies set out in the draft Isle of Wight Shoreline Management Plan, and summarised within the appendix of the report be approved and that the three month public consultation stage be allowed to commence.
Reasons for decision	To balance the management of coastal flooding and erosion risks, with natural processes, and the consequences of climate change.
Additional reasons	To determine technically, economically and environmentally sustainable policies for management of the shoreline for the next 100 years (2005-2105), split into three time periods: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Present day (0-20 years) • Medium-term (20-50 years) • Long-term (50-100 years)
Options considered and rejected	Option 2 – To vary some or all of the draft coastal defence policies set out in the draft Isle of Wight Shoreline Management Plan, and summarised in the appendix of the report, and authorise the three month public consultation stage to commence.
