<b>Decision reference</b>	06/11
<b>Decision taken</b>	Option 1 – to accept the proposed new chief officer structure.  Option 3 - that any vacant posts are subject to recruitment as soon as possible
<b>Reasons for decision</b>	To enable the council to reduce spend on the management tiers within the Authority by £7.25m in a full year from 2012/13.
<b>Additional reasons</b>	To enable the Council to have sufficient staff to meet the principles for future organisation of the Council, as agreed by Cabinet on 7 December 2010,
<b>Options considered and rejected</b>	Option 2 – to ask the Chief Executive to find other savings other than by reducing chief officer posts to the proposed level;
