Decision reference	37/11
Decision taken	Option 1 - To agree to enter into a contract for the provision of domiciliary care and supported living services for learning disabled people with complex and challenging needs residing at White Lodge, Newport, Isle of Wight for the term of three years; with the option to extend for a further 2 years with TQtwentyone.
Reasons for decision	To move the residents of White Lodge into independent supporting living arrangements To focus on looking at people's whole lives, not individual problems, and fitting services around their needs, thereby helping them live healthier, more independent lives. To bring care into the community and provide easier access to services.
Additional reasons	To provide better information and improve health care for people with ongoing needs. To provide help for carers as well as joined up (collaborative) care
Options considered and rejected	Option 2 - Not to agree to enter into a contract for the provision of domiciliary care and supported living services for learning disabled people with complex and challenging needs residing at White Lodge, Newport, Isle of Wight with TQtwentyone.
