[ADOPTION OF VILLAGE DESIGN STATEMENTS \(VDS\) AS SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING GUIDANCE](#)

The Countryside Design Summary provided a solid background for the production of Village Design Statements on the Island. The VDS initiative would give local communities a greater say in the way change was managed their village, in particular how planned development was carried out.

Village Design Statements described the qualities and characteristics that people valued in their village and its surroundings. It set out clear and simple guidance for development design and was intended to be used as an advisory document in planning decisions as a supplement to the UDP. The VDS was not about whether development should or should not take place, as that was the role of the UDP.

The Portfolio Holder considered the final draft VDS for Bembridge and Ningwood and was informed that the documents were broadly in line with the policies contained within the UDP. Local Members had been involved at various stages of their production.
