Item	Safety Camera, Victoria Avenue, Shanklin
Decision reference	51/08
Decision taken	To leave the camera in Victoria Avenue and continue to operate it in accordance with the Safer Roads Partnership policy.
Reasons for decision	To confirm the Council's policy in respect of the safety camera in Victoria Avenue Shanklin in the light of requests for its removal.
Additional reasons	Since the deployment of the camera in 2004 there has been a significant reduction in collisions involving personal injury and vehicle speeds and there is no reason to expect that these would not be maintained with the continued deployment of the camera in accordance with the Safer Roads Partnership policy.
Options considered and rejected	To remove the camera immediately.
