



Application for Hedgerow Removal Notice

NATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- A completed form or the form set out in Schedule 4 to the Hedgerow Regulations 1997
- A plan which clearly shows the location and length of the hedgerow(s) to be removed (if possible, please provide a plan to a scale of 1:2500. A different scale can be used so long as it shows clearly the location and length of the hedgerow or hedgerows that you wish to remove)
- Evidence of the date of planting

LOCAL REQUIREMENTS

Additional Mandatory Documents	Photographs and photomontages to show hedge to be removed
	Landscaping details The details shall include:- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Details of planting areas (including new planted species) • Clear identification of where existing planting is proposed to be kept • Proposals for long term maintenance and landscape management of both retained existing landscaping and new areas of landscaping.

Conditional Documents Required	Document Type	Circumstances when document should be submitted
	Biodiversity survey and report	<p>Any development likely to affect a local or national designated nature conservation habitat or one which would have impact on a designated protected species.
