1. I am directed by the Secretary of State for Transport to refer to the above-named Orders which have been submitted by your Council for confirmation. In your letter dated 3 December 2007 you advised that Council Members at a meeting of the Cabinet on the 20 November resolved not to proceed with the currently proposed scheme and that your Council wish to withdraw the Orders.

2. For this reason, the Secretary of State has decided to not confirm -

- (i) The Isle of Wight Council A3055 (Undercliff Drive – Highway Realignment Classified Road) (Side Roads) Order 2006; and
- (ii) The Isle of Wight Council (Undercliff Drive Highway Realignment) Compulsory Purchase Order 2006

and this letter constitutes her decision to that effect. The Sealed Orders, plans and maps which were enclosed with your applications are returned herewith.

3. The Secretary of State's decision does not preclude the making of fresh Orders. If new Orders are to be made, it may be necessary for a fresh resolution to be passed. Any new Orders would also require re-advertisement in the Press and fresh service of notice on interested parties.

4. In the event of fresh Orders being made by your Council and submitted to the Secretary of State for confirmation, the Secretary of State will take into account all objections or representations made in respect of those Orders, but no objections or representations made in respect of the Orders which she has declined to confirm.

5. A copy of this letter has been sent to those persons who objected to the Orders. Your Council is hereby requested to serve notice of this decision on all other persons on whom notices were served notifying them of the Orders submissions.
