

How do I join?

You can use some services without joining, but to borrow items or use the computers you will need to become a library member.

Just bring some ID showing your name (for example— your driving licence, bank statement or rent book).

How much can I borrow?

You can borrow up to 30 items at a time in total, but there is a limit on how many of these can be DVDs, talking books and language courses.

How long can I keep them for?

You may borrow books free of charge for three weeks. You may rent DVDs for one night or one week, CDs for one week and language courses and talking books for 3 weeks.

Please note that there are charges for these rentals.

What about fines?

There are fines for overdue adult books, DVDs, CDs and talking books. Children under 16 will not be charged fines on overdue books. Please note that if we need to send you an overdue reminder letter, it will cost you 60p (this also applies to under 16s).

What if the item I want isn't available?

If the item you require is not available here, we can usually obtain it for you. Simply ask a member of staff, or visit our website.

Specially for young adults

There is a separate section for teenagers with popular titles and Manga selection.

Are there any regular events in the library?

We hold an over 60's group, a regular book group, a poetry group, 'Knit and Natter' sessions, untutored art group and genealogy sessions.

Specially for children

The children's library has books, DVDs and talking books for all ages from babies upwards.
