





1. Overview

Apprenticeships combine practical training in a job with study. As an apprentice you'll:

work alongside experienced staff
gain job-specific skills
earn a wage and get holiday pay
study towards a related qualification (usually one day a week)

Apprenticeships take 1 to 4 years to complete depending on their level.

2. Levels of apprenticeship

An apprenticeship has an equivalent education level and can be:

Intermediate - equivalent to 5 GCSE passes
Advanced - equivalent to 2 A level passes
Higher - can lead to NVQ Level 4 and above, or a foundation degree

3. Who can apply

You can apply for an apprenticeship if you're:

16 or over eligible to work in England not in full-time education

- 3. Complete and submit your application.

PEST CONTROL TECHNICIAN

As a pest control technician you would identify, control and get rid of pests like rodents such as rats or mice, and insects like wasps, ants or cockroaches. If you have an interest in health and safety and enjoy practical work, then this could be the career for you.

You'll need excellent communication and customer service skills. Being physically fit will help you to work in areas where pests may be found like cramped spaces or at heights.

There is no set entry route to become a pest control technician. Most employers will expect you to have good maths and English skills, and many will train you on the job.

As a pest control technician, it would be your job to get rid of infestations of pests and vermin. You would use a range of chemicals and equipment to deal with insect pests and animals such as rats, mice, foxes, moles and birds (known as vertebrate pests).

You might treat infestations anywhere from people's homes to restaurants, sewers, warehouses or farms. Your work would include:

- investigating and identifying pests
- collecting dead animals and other samples for scientific analysis
- finding out how the pests are getting in
- choosing the most suitable way of controlling the pest
- spraying chemicals to get rid of insects (known as 'fumigation')
- laying poison and traps or using weapons such as air-guns to control birds and animals
- proofing an area to stop pests returning
- advising people how to prevent further infestation
- completing reports and keeping records
- following the correct procedures for handling and storing pesticides and disposing of dead or captured animals.

CHILD EMPLOYMENT

Children (under 16 years of age) are not allowed to work:

- without an employment permit issued by the education department of the local council, if this is required by local bylaws
- in places like a factory or industrial site
- during school hours
- before 7am or after 7pm
- for more than one hour before school (unless local bylaws allow it)
- for more than 4 hours without taking a break of at least 1 hour
- · in most jobs in pubs and betting shops and those prohibited in local bylaws
- in any work that may be harmful to their health, well-being or education
- without having a 2-week break from any work during the school holidays in each calendar year

There are also special rules which only apply during term times and school holiday times.

Term time rules

During term time children can only work a maximum of 12 hours a week. This includes:

- a maximum of 2 hours on school days and Sundays
- a maximum of 5 hours on Saturdays for 13 to 14-year-olds, or 8 hours for 15 to 16-year-olds

School holiday rules

During school holidays 13 to 14-year-olds are only allowed to work a maximum of 25 hours a week. This includes:

- a maximum of 5 hours on weekdays and Saturdays
- a maximum of 2 hours on Sunday

During school holidays 15 to 16-year-olds can only work a maximum of 35 hours a week. This includes:

- a maximum of 8 hours on weekdays and Saturdays
- a maximum of 2 hours on Sunday


