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1.0 Details about the provision that was inspected

The service offers Young people from ages 11-19 the chance to experience cricket in an exciting, fun environment led by qualified coaches.

Overview of the organisation/service:

The opportunity to experience the game of cricket in an exciting, fun environment. You will learn or improve how you hit, bowl, throw and catch as well as playing lots of fun games of cricket whilst making friends.

What they provide:

The opportunity to experience the game of cricket in an exciting, fun environment. They learn how to hit, bowl, throw and catch as well as play lots of fun games of cricket while making friends.

When is it available: Saturdays from 16th April to 8th October at 11.30-1pm.

How much is the costs: £3 per session

2.0 Introduction – Why we inspected Isle Jump?

We decided to inspect Isle of Wight Cricket board as they are an established provider to Short Breaks. It was inspected to capture the views and opinions of young people who attended the activity.

3.0 Methodology – How we inspected Isle Jump?

The inspection took place at a Saturday session. Two Young Inspectors went along to participate in the session being offered.

4.0 Review analysis- What we reviewed

4.1 Staff

Young Inspectors stated that they were greeted nicely and “Graham helped and made it fun”.

4.2 Fun and enjoyment

Young Inspectors had lots of fun during the session and one of the Young Inspectors was particularly looking forward to attending the session again with the possibility of joining the cricket team.

One of the Young Inspectors said “I didn’t think I would enjoy it, but it was actually quite good fun!”

4.3 Accessibility

There were no issues with accessibility. The building was on ground level and the door was easy accessible with ample free parking outside of the building. The session could easily be accessed by a wheelchair user. The Young Inspectors thought the session was “cheap” and “worth it”.

4.4 Safety and Surroundings

The Young Inspectors that participated felt that they were safe and that Graham was helpful and nice. “He showed us how to throw the ball safely without injuring ourselves or others”. The Young Inspectors were not made aware of any fire procedures and when asked about the fire procedure Graham was unsure of the arrangements or if there was another fire door at the back of the building.

4.5 Food and Dining experience

There was a vending machine on site but the Young Inspectors had brought their own drinks.

5.0 Summary of Inspection - What the Young Inspectors found

Young Inspectors were asked to inspect the safety and surroundings, the staff, accessibility and the fun and enjoyment of the activity.

Young Inspectors felt they were safe throughout the session that they participated in. They commented on how friendly the other young people were.

The session is inclusive for all.

6.0 Recommendations – How the activity can be made better?

6.1 Young Inspectors views

Young Inspectors felt that the session was very good and was made fun by Graham.

6.2 Young Inspectors Lead recommendations

I feel the session was run very well, and Graham included everyone who attended by allowing them all in turn to bat, bowl and field.

I would like to note that the staff need to make young people and their carers/parents aware of the fire safety procedure and exits.
